**Solidarity Trade Union / Brian Molefe & Others – GD case no: 34042/17 / SCA ref: 503/18 / CC ref: 136/19**

- 1 The above matter, your letter dated 13 August 2019, and the order of the Constitutional Court of South Africa (CC), dated 29 July 2019, bear reference.
- 2 On receipt of the Constitutional Court order, our client instructed us to immediately proceed to compel payment in accordance with paragraph (c) of the judgment of the Gauteng Division of the High Court, Pretoria, which was handed down on 25 January 2018 and 17 April 2018. This is also, in circumstances where this position was confirmed by the recent CC judgment.
- 3 As such, on 08 August 2019 we wrote to Mr Molefe's attorneys of record, Rambevhla Morobane Attorneys, advising them of their client's indebtedness in accordance with the judgment and our client's intention compel payment. We have given them 10 (ten) days, within which to ensure that payment is made to our clients bank account. Effectively, they have until **Thursday, 22 August 2019** to provide us with proof of payment of the aforesaid amount. Should the payment not be forthcoming, our instructions are to take further steps in execution of the judgment debt.
- 4 In the interim, we will wait for compliance to our client's letter of demand. Once the *dies* lapses, and to the extent that there is non-compliance, we will, in terms of our instructions, vigorously proceed with enforcement of the judgment debt through court processes.
- 5 We trust that you will find the above in order.
